



# **Oriel College Graduate Scholarship in Science and Religion**

**Oriel College, Oxford**

Oriel College offers a Graduate Studentship in Science and Religion, tenable from Michaelmas Term 2026. This £10,000 scholarship will be awarded annually for up to three years to a DPhil student at Oriel College whose research focuses on the intersection of theology and scientific thought. Students from all disciplines (including those outside of Theology) are eligible.

The successful candidate receives the following benefits:

- Financial award of £10,000 per year
- Guaranteed College accommodation for at least the first year of their course

Awards are subject to satisfactory academic progress being made, and are tenable only at Oriel College. A successful candidate with a place at another College would migrate to Oriel to take up the award.

This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with other awards where the combined value would exceed the total cost of course fees and a UKRI equivalent stipend. This award is tenable only during the period of fee liability for the course of the selected scholar.
